<b>Definition</b>	A mental illness characterized by an excessive irrational concern for one's health and conviction in the presence of a disease for which there is no objective evidence. <b>Occurrence</b>	Distributed equally between both sexes. Occurs most often in elderly people.	Occurs more common in women, in elderly people, and in individuals with low socio-economic status.
<b>Symptoms</b>	Preoccupation with fears of having, or the conviction of having one or more progressive disorders, based on a misinterpretation of symptoms.	Pain, fatigue, loss of appetite, and other gastrointestinal problems with no specific medical reason for their occurrence.
<b>Causes</b>	Depression, panic disorder, misunderstanding of the physical feelings and the way the body works, hereditary factors, severe health problems in the past, etc.	Chronic stress.
<b>Treatment</b>	Cognitive therapy, helping patients to rationalize their fears, and medications, reducing anxiety.	Medications and/or psychotherapy, based on the severity and type of the symptoms and the age of the patient.
