The study focusses on the cross cultural contexts in one of the states in South India and the Netherlands Karnataka in the recent times is experiencing fertility transition while the Netherlands has already achieved fertility transition. The two cultural contexts are both diverse and unique in character. The author explores both the uniqueness as well as the similarities hence studying the impact of higher education on the changing lives of women as a continuum across cultures and societies. Changes at the individual level are captured by distinguishing women into older and younger generations while changes at the societal level are captured through social change. At the individual level we distinguish between the lived life course and the perceived life course.
