Through the Smoke of Budapest 50 Years On The February 2006 Conference of the London Socialist Historians Group was held at the Institute of Historical Research in central London one of a series of such conferences over the previous ten years Assembled were a modest group of academics and activists come to mark the 50th anniversary of the events of 1956 and to do so in a particular way Firstly by presenting new historical research on the questions under review rather than trotting out
