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Checklist Partners in Print Julie Nelson Davis, 2014-12-31 This compelling account of collaboration in the genre of ukiyo e pictures of the floating world offers a new approach to understanding the production and reception of print culture in early modern Japan. It provides a corrective to the perception that the ukiyo e tradition was the product of the creative talents of individual artists, revealing instead the many identities that made and disseminated printed work. Julie Nelson Davis demonstrates by way of examples from the later eighteenth century that this popular genre was the result of an exchange among publishers, designers, writers, carvers, printers, patrons, buyers, and readers. By recasting these works as examples of a network of commercial and artistic cooperation, she offers a nuanced view of the complexity of this tradition and expands our understanding of the dynamic processes of production, reception, and intention in floating world print culture. Four case studies give evidence of what constituted modes of collaboration among artistic producers in the period. In each case, Davis explores a different configuration of collaboration: that between a teacher and a student, two painters and their publishers, a designer and a publisher, and a writer and an illustrator. Each investigates a mode of partnership through a single work: a specially commissioned print, a lavishly illustrated album, a printed handscroll, and an inexpensive illustrated novel. These case studies explore the diversity of printed things in the period, ranging from expensive works made for a select circle of connoisseurs to those meant to be sold at a modest price to a large audience. They take up familiar subjects from the floating world: connoisseurship, beauty, sex, and humor, and explore multiple dimensions of inquiry vital to that dynamic culture: the status of art, the evaluation of beauty, the representation of sexuality, and the tension between mind and body. Where earlier studies of woodblock prints have tended to focus on the individual artist, *Partners in Print* takes the subject a major step forward to a richer picture of the creative process. Placing these works in their period context not only reveals an aesthetic network responsive to and shaped by the desires of consumers in a specific place and time, but also contributes to a larger discussion about the role of art and the place of the material text in the early modern world.

Japan and Taiwan The chapters are broadly divided into two parts 1 Politics and Society and 2 Arts and Literature although the texts included in the second part also deal with social themes In addition to historical topics such as Japanese colonialism or Chinese agricultural reforms in the 1950s the volume also addresses current issues including restrictive Chinese policies in Xinjiang Japanese activist movements against gender based violence and discrimination or the problems of migrant laborers in India and performing arts in Japan during the COVID 19 pandemic Likewise it provides insight into satirical woodblock prints from the Boshin War period or works of literature produced in Japanese leprosariums in the first half of the 20th century as well as into selected topics in contemporary Chinese Japanese and Sinophone Tibetan literature Collectively the chapters comprised in this volume narrate the multifaceted relationship between voice and power thus highlighting the fact that the question of voice is closely intertwined with a variety of social political and cultural issues Print Quarterly, 2008

Impressions , 2009 **Utagawa Kuniyoshi** Sarah Elizabeth Thompson, 2009 Originally published in 1852 and 1853 The Sixty nine Stations of the Kisokaid is a richly entertaining series of woodblock prints created by master artist Utagawa Kuniyoshi Japanese 1797 1861 The seventy two finely executed prints include one for each resting point along the well traveled Kisokaid Kiso Road a historic route stretching from Edo modern Tokyo to Kyoto plus views of the two endpoint cities and an additional series title page Kuniyoshi never traveled the mountainous Kisokaid but he drew from historic events kabuki plays popular legends and classical literature to illustrate his vision of the towns and stations along the road This stunning collection of colorful ukiyo e prints exhibits Kuniyoshi s artistic mastery and clever sense of humor Each work incorporates three elements the main picture an inset landscape depicting the particular station and a title block Using parody and pun both for humor and to avoid government censorship Kuniyoshi associated each point on the route with one of the most beloved stories of his day from a reimagined Odyssey to the Japanese fairy tale of Urashima to popular kabuki scenes with courtesans and other floating world characters He made that story the subject of the main picture and put clues to its identity in the title block Kuniyoshi delighted in these hidden messages and used every inch of the paper to tell his story Utagawa Kuniyoshi The Sixty nine Stations of the Kisokaid celebrates the beauty charm and ingenuity of Kuniyoshi s work with more than seventy five full color illustrations including reproductions of all the prints in the treasured series Sarah E Thompson provides an introductory essay on the history of ukiyo e and a description of each print Sarah E Thompson
