Through case studies they examine the reproduction, support and rejection of antisemitic tropes alongside quantitative assessments of comment structures in online discussions. Additionally the volume delves into the capabilities of content moderation tools and deep learning models for automated hate speech detection. This multidisciplinary approach provides a comprehensive understanding of contemporary antisemitism in digital spaces recognising the importance of addressing its insidious spread from multiple angles.
