$$K_k = Q_k R_k$$

The tridiagonal matrices  $T_k$  are the corresponding projections

$$T_k = Q_k^* A Q_k$$

And the successive iterates are related by the formula

$$A Q_k = Q_{k+1} \begin{bmatrix} T_k \\ \beta_k e_k \end{bmatrix} = Q_k T_k + \beta_k q_{k+1} e_k^*$$
