One dimension that must be emphasized in this field is the continuum that exists between social environment and cerebral development. This continuum consists of the physical and biological features of the two interacting systems on one hand the brain managed and controlled by the genetic program and on the other hand the environment be it natural or social. A simple dichotomy of individual and environment is no longer a sufficient concept in understanding the etiology of mental health and illness. Needless to say socioepidemiological research in psychiatry and transcultural psychiatry is useful in reaching these ends. However at the root of mental illness one can always find the same causal elements: informational chaos, inadequate dietary intake, substance abuse, trauma, conditioning and so on which make the interactive systems dysfunctional. Subsequent organic and psychotic disorders occur to the detriment of both the individual and society. Current biological psychiatry is inadequately equipped in treating mental illness.
