These changes resulted in the revitalization of the society and made possible the Quakers' campaign against slavery, thus distinguishing them as the first group of people in history to espouse abolition. Marietta draws on a wealth of data over 10,000 disciplinary cases in the Society's records, dating from 1682. The author's description and evaluation of the role, status, and treatment of women in the Society is sympathetic and what emerges from his interpretation is a sensitive portrayal not only of withdrawal but of the substitution of a vision different from the one that inspired the "Holy Experiment".
