**Textile and Garment Companies in the Philippines** Patrick Bolte, 2005-06-18 Diploma Thesis from the year 2004 in the subject Politics Topic Globalization Political Economics grade 1 3 Free University of Berlin Otto Suhr Institut für Politikwissenschaft language English abstract Over the first four years of its existence the Global Compact has made significant progress in terms of outputs but is threatened by its participants poor performance in rule compliance It has managed to secure small but reasonable funding and improved in the fields of guidance to participants inclusiveness and transparency It has proved to be adaptable to challenges as the introduction of the integrity measures and the addition of a tenth principle on anti corruption indicate However the lack of any enforcement of its rules that persisted until June 2004 appears to have been a model deficiency Up until the introduction of the integrity measures in that month the voluntary nature of Kofi Annan's initiative seems to have been over stretched as poor outcomes suggest While it has gained hundreds of new participants and now consists of nearly 1 700 most of these participants failed to fulfil their obligations of 1 integrating the principles into business operations 2 publicly advocating the Compact and 3 annually reporting on progress At least 1015 participants did not submit the required communication on progress COP Although this paper recognises the achievements of some participants as well as indirect outcomes amongst participants such as strengthening champions of reform within companies these successes do not make up for the huge reporting gap Conceivably all participants that did not submit COPs might have acted upon the principles nonetheless but even were this so in all cases the reporting gap posed at the very least a threat to the initiative's transparency and integrity However it is more likely that the reporting gap represents an actual implementation gap a gap that poses a much greater danger to the Global Compact's credibility and long term viability The Philippine Global Compact network was established in September 2001 its 137 members make it the third largest of the 44 networks after France and Spain Its dynamics reveal some of the root causes behind the participants poor performance in reporting The network's inception was spearheaded by the Employers Confederation of the Philippines ECOP and the International Labour Organisation ILO the initiative soon gained the support of the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry PCCI Philippine Business for Social Progress PBSP and the United Nations Development Programme

**Black Social Capital** Marion Orr, 1999 Deindustrialization white flight and inner city poverty have spelled trouble for Baltimore schools Marion Orr now examines why school reform has been difficult to achieve there revealing the struggles of civic leaders and the limitations placed on Baltimore's African American community as each has tried to rescue a failing school system Examining the interplay between government and society Orr presents the first systematic analysis of social capital both within the African American community black social capital and outside it where social capital crosses racial lines Orr shows that while

black social capital may have created solidarity against white domination in Baltimore it hampered African American leaders capacity to enlist the cooperation from white corporate elites and suburban residents needed for school reform Orr examines social capital at the neighborhood level in elite level interactions and in intergovernmental relations to argue that black social capital doesn't necessarily translate into the kind of intergroup coalition needed to bring about school reform He also includes an extensive historical survey of the black community showing how distrust engendered by past black experiences has hampered the formation of significant intergroup social capital The book features case studies of school reform activity including the first analysis of the politics surrounding Baltimore's decision to hire a private for profit firm to operate nine of its public schools These cases illuminate the paradoxical aspects of black social capital in citywide school reform while offering critical perspectives on current debates about privatization site based management and other reform alternatives Orr's book challenges those who argue that social capital alone can solve fundamentally political problems by purely social means and questions the efficacy of either privatization or black community power to reform urban schools Black Social Capital offers a cogent conceptual synthesis of social capital theory and urban regime theory that demonstrates the importance of government politics and leadership in converting social capital into a resource that can be mobilized for effective social change

No Child Left Behind and the Transformation of Federal Education Policy, 1965-2005 Patrick J. federal leadership in school reform then details the negotiations over NCLB the forces that shaped its final provisions and the ways in which the law constitutes a new federal education policy regime against which states have now begun to rebel and that only by understanding the unique dynamics of national education politics will reformers be able to craft a more effective national role in school reform     *Nuclear Politics in America* Robert J. Duffy, 1997 Duffy's work traces nuclear politics from the creation of a powerful subgovernment through the public lobby reforms of the late 1960s and early 1970s and the deregulatory backlash of the Reagan years. He demonstrates that while policies did change in the 1970s, they did not change as much as other accounts have suggested and that the industry continued to receive considerable federal support. The book is particularly significant for extending the discussion of nuclear policy through the Bush and Clinton years including the controversy over waste disposal, new licensing procedures enacted in the 1992 Amendments to the Atomic Energy Act and the effects of deregulation of electric utilities.
