areas and landscape ecological projects are urgently required to preserve them As a result of global warming abnormal weather phenomena including super typhoons have occurred frequently in recent years The major underlying cause is the higher concentration of greenhouse gases released by human activities As well major natural absorbers of CO₂ such as forests wetlands and coral reefs are shrinking and the human impact is causing the ecological balance to deteriorate Controlling CO₂ emissions and expanding the CO₂ absorbers are keys to reducing total CO₂ Low carbon societies can be established by maintaining the original CO₂ balance through integration of multiple tools with contributions from diverse fields such as physics and chemistry physiology and humanities and education On the basis of an international consensus the environment must be protected no matter what sacrifices are required As this book demonstrates achieving a low carbon society is a top priority and landscape conservation is the first step in ecological research toward that goal
