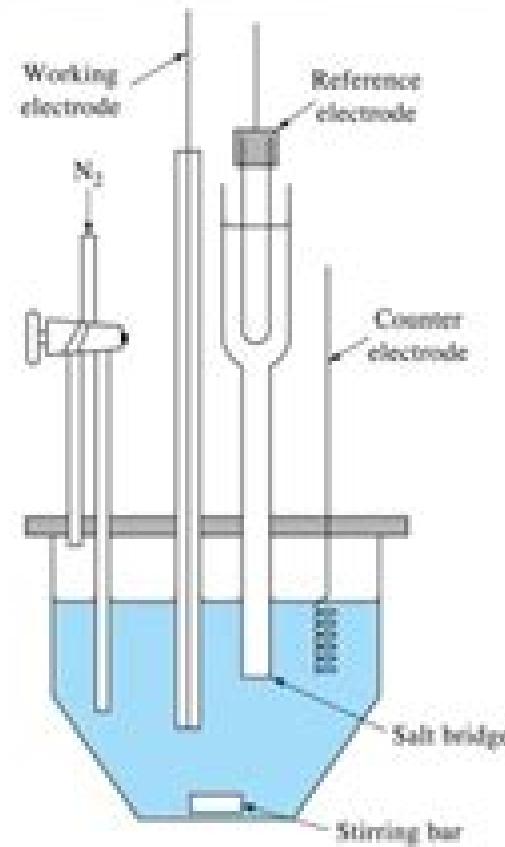


Fig. 25-8 (p.724) A three-electrode cell for hydrodynamic voltammetry.
