Colette Anderson has brought together some facts concerning each of these and many more wild species from around the world as she feels each is worthy of our admiration and protection. That is my major goal with this book. In the end I hope your eyes will be opened to a whole new world of small wild cats. To encourage the reader to get more involved, there is a collection of conservation websites provided for, although many are endangered, all can be saved by the efforts of people genuinely interested in their preservation and protection.
