


earned him the Distinguished Flying Cross long before he earned a collection of medals in Vietnam. Despite the many accolades Kittinger's proudest moment remains his free fall from 102,800 feet during which he achieved a speed of 614 miles per hour. Drawing upon flight reports and technical data this book documents Project Manhigh and the high altitude flights that preceded it. The Manhigh flights were in many ways prototypes for future space missions. On each of the three flights the Air Force placed a lone pilot in a sealed capsule nineteen miles above the ground. At such extreme altitudes the pilots were well within the functional equivalent of outer space and needed the sealed capsule to survive. Manhigh existed prior to the creation of NASA and helped pave the way for human space exploration.
