Austria

Estimated population: 8,740,000 million (2016)
Joined the European Union in: 1995

Capital: Vienna

Official language: Austrian and German

Highest peak: Mount Grossglockner (3,798 m high)

Austria is located in south-central Europe and is bound across 8 borders including the Czech Republic, Hungary, Slovakia, Slovenia, Switzerland, Germany, Italy and Liechtenstein.

Climate: In Austria's capital, Vienna, the average temperature during summer is 19 degrees, while dropping to an average of -1 degrees in winter.

Austria is also famous for its stunning mountainous landscape. There are 36 peaks which are above 3,000 metres high and 60% of Austria's lands are covered by the Austrian Alps. The country is a paradise for skiers and the tourists, however it has limited natural resources such as oil, coal and timber which must be imported from other countries.

Joined the European Union in: 1972

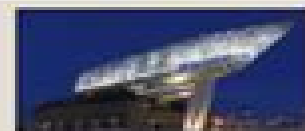
Capital: Brussels

Climate: In summer, Belgium's capital city, Brussels, reaches an average temperature of 22 degrees and drops to -1 degrees during winter months. Belgium is famous for producing the world's smallest chocolate, which weighs 5mm. The chocolate industry has been around for over 400 years within the Belgium borders. 400,000 tons of chocolate is made in the country. The country has varied landscapes that consist of forests and grassy fields and the rolling plains which constitute most of the countryside.

Capital: Sofia

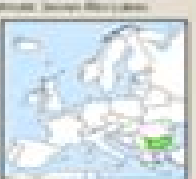
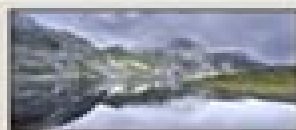
Official language: Bulgarian

Capital: Zagreb

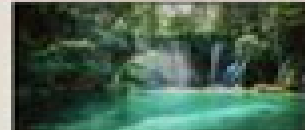
Official language: Croatian

Official language: Greek and Turkish

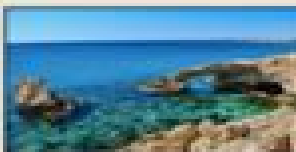
Highest peak: Mount Olympus (2,524 m high)

Capital: Prague

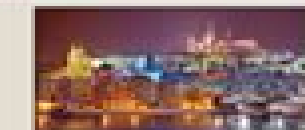
Official language: Czech

European Theatre Audiences Joshua Edelman, Attila Szabó, Hedi-Liis Toome, Marline Lisette Wilders, Antine Zijlstra, 2025-04-25 This book reports on one of the largest co-ordinated efforts to survey the theatrical audience experience the City Study of the Project on European Theatre Systems which conducted over 7000 surveys and dozens of interviews and focus groups with audience members from four mid-sized cities across Europe. This study aimed to capture the details of how audiences perceive and value theatre and resulted in a data set which while imperfect has no precedent in scale and comparability for theatre studies. Based on this very large data set the authors were able to create a portrait of varied segments of European theatrical audiences its experiences and how it values theatre that is more detailed and incisive than any previously available. The question is not just who comes to theatre but why and how those experiences are valuable to them. This book's key contribution however is methodological that offers a detailed and unsparing examination of the City Study's working methods their underlying theory their strengths and weaknesses and which survey and interview techniques were more successful in bringing out useful information.
