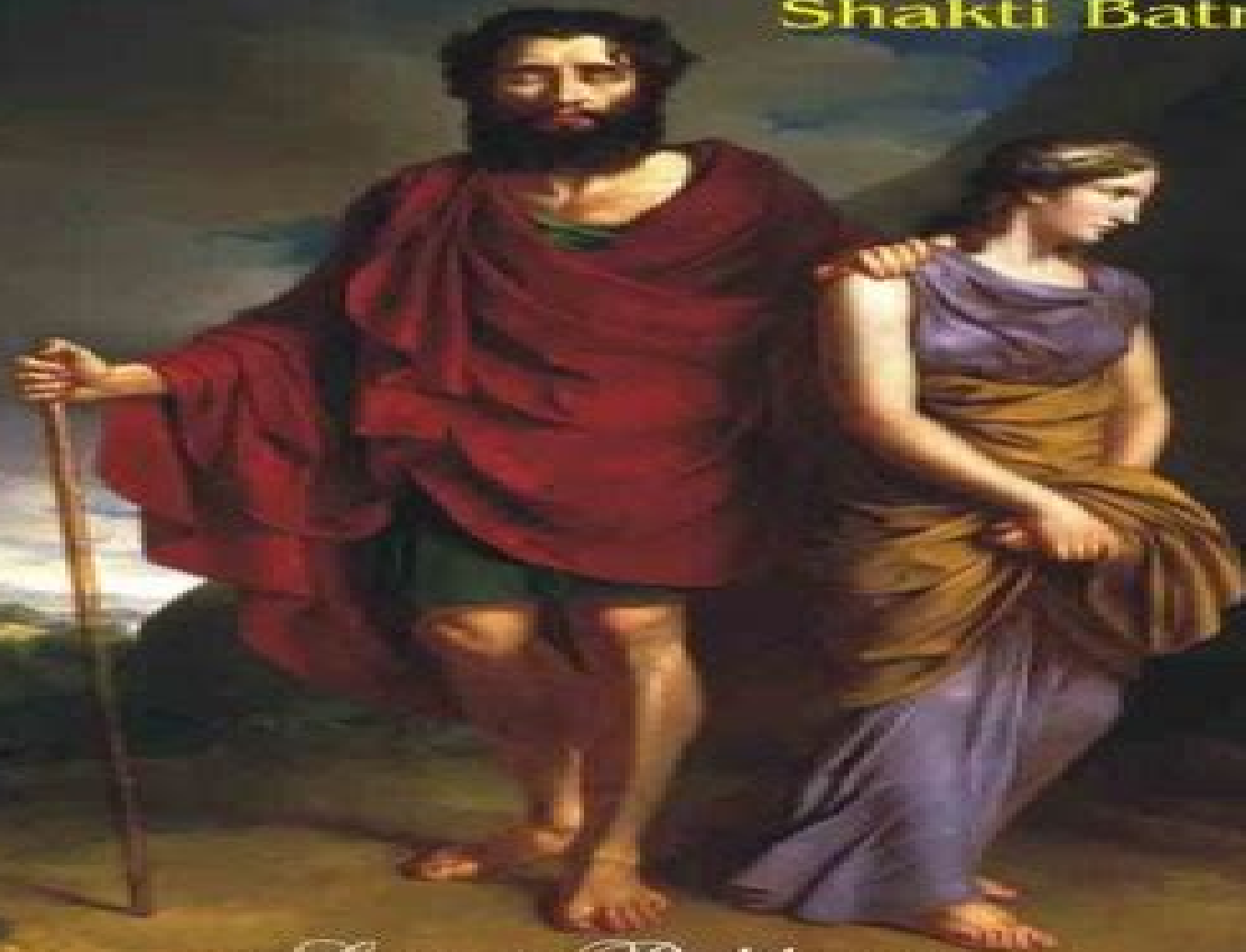

the oracle was consulted and it bade them purge themselves of blood guiltiness Oedipus denounces the crime of which he is unaware and undertakes to track out the criminal Step by step it is brought home to him that he is the man The closing scene reveals Jocasta slain by her own hand and Oedipus blinded by his own act and praying for death or exile
