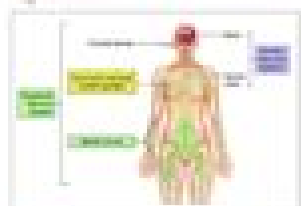

### RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

#### Functions

- 1. Ventilation - moving air in and out of the lungs
- 2. External respiration - exchanging oxygen and carbon dioxide between the lungs and the blood
- 3. Internal respiration - exchanging oxygen and carbon dioxide between the blood and the cells
- 4. Gas transport - moving oxygen and carbon dioxide through the blood
- 5. pH regulation - maintaining the balance of acids and bases in the blood
