Editors,2014-04-18 Includes historic pictures of the fighting Includes pictures of important people places and events Includes a bibliography for further reading If you die there will be no one left who knows the truth about the battle of Okinawa Bear the temporary shame but endure it This is an order from your army Commander Mitsuru Ushijima to Colonel Hiromichi Yahara Near the end of 1944 as Allied forces were pushing across the Pacific and edging ever closer to Japan plans were drawn up to invade the Ryuku islands the most prominent of them being Okinawa Military planners anticipated that an amphibious campaign would last a week but instead of facing 60 000 Japanese defenders as estimated there were closer to 120 000 on the island at the beginning of the campaign in April 1945 The Battle of Okinawa was the largest amphibious operation in the Pacific theater and it would last nearly 3 months and wind up being the fiercest in the Pacific theater during the war with nearly 60 000 American casualties and over 100 000 Japanese soldiers killed In addition the battle resulted in an estimated 40 000 150 000 Japanese civilian casualties Okinawa witnessed every conceivable horror of war both on land and at sea American ground forces on Okinawa had to deal with bad weather including a typhoon anti tank moats barbed wire mines caves underground tunnel networks and fanatical Japanese soldiers who were willing to use human shields while fighting to the death Allied naval forces supporting the amphibious invasion had to contend with Japan's notorious kamikazes suicide pilots who terrorized sailors as they frantically tried to shoot down the Japanese planes before they could hit Allied ships As one sailor aboard the USS Miami recalled They came in swarms from all directions The barrels of our ship's guns got so hot we had to use firehoses to cool them down As The Marine Corps Gazette noted More mental health issues arose from the Battle of Okinawa than any other battle in the Pacific during World War II The constant bombardment from artillery and mortars coupled with the high casualty rates led to a great deal of men coming down with combat fatigue Additionally the rains caused mud that prevented tanks from moving and tracks from pulling out the dead forcing Marines who pride

themselves on burying their dead in a proper and honorable manner to leave their comrades where they lay This coupled with thousands of bodies both friend and foe littering the entire island created a scent you could nearly taste Morale was dangerously low by the month of May and the state of discipline on a moral basis had a new low barometer for acceptable behavior The ruthless atrocities by the Japanese throughout the war had already brought on an altered behavior deemed so by traditional standards by many Americans resulting in the desecration of Japanese remains but the Japanese tactic of using the Okinawan people as human shields brought about a new aspect of terror and torment to the psychological capacity of the Americans Given the horrific nature of the combat and the fact that it was incessant for several weeks it's no surprise that Okinawa had a profound psychological effect on the men who fought but it also greatly influenced the thinking of military leaders who were planning subsequent campaigns including a potential invasion of the Japanese mainland The fighting at places like Iwo Jima and Okinawa went a long way toward swaying the beliefs of American military advisors that invading Japan itself would cause millions of casualties which ultimately helped compel President Truman to use the atomic bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki in an effort to end the war before having to attempt such an invasion Descent Into Hell, 2014 In 1983 concerned about the need to record and explain the experiences of Okinawans caught up in Battle of Okinawa the local Ryukyu Shimpo newspaper carried out several hundred interviews with survivors With explanatory comment added this was published first in serial form then later as a book Tens of thousands of Okinawans were killed in the relentless bombardment by American forces ten of thousands more local recruits died in Home Guard units thousands of starvation and malaria in places away from the fighting hundreds of young students died in the Blood and Iron Student Corps or as nurse's aides tending to wounded soldiers in hospital caves and hundreds of evacuees lost their lives in ships sunk by U S submarines or aircraft There were even people who took their own lives or the lives of loved ones to avoid what they had been told by the Japanese Army would be a far worse fate at the hands of American captors Descent into Hell is the story of this apocalyptic struggle as told by those Okinawans who survived Seven Stars Simon Bolivar Buckner, Joseph Warren Stilwell, 2004 Battle diaries are essential for understanding what generals are thinking as they work their way through the fog of battle Nicholas Sarantakes juxtaposes the diaries of two very different generals who both fought at Okinawa Lt Gen Buckner a by the numbers man who favored the use of artillery and tanks to reduce entrenched positions and Gen Stilwell a prickly outsider who preferred maneuver to set piece battles Sarantakes identifies individuals includes explanations of important events alluded to by the generals and provides glossaries of main characters and military terms The result is a record of how Buckner and Stilwell came to grips with the problems of command on a war torn island at the end of a long logistical tether With the background information provided by Sarantakes the diaries of these men become accessible to the reader Buckner is the more restrained a southern gentleman whose career was average and whose diary entries are interspersed with letters to his wife He shuttles between forward command posts and shipboard conferences noting how much rain has fallen how

many enemy have been killed and how many aircraft have been shot down Stilwell is a self styled outsider a brilliant warrior with the social graces of a porcupine He dislikes Buckner and has little patience for his irreverent humor Stilwell writes Buckner is tiresome I tried to tell him what I had seen but he knew it all Keeps repeating his wise cracks The Lord said let there be mud etc etc June 5 1944 Stilwell s entries are peppered with frank and often acrid observations about everything and everybody He dismisses the British as hoggish inconsiderate Limeys and atomic scientists as temperamental bugs The battle for Okinawa was a pivotal event in World War II and has the distinction of being the single bloodiest conflict in the history of the United States Navy The diaries of these two men provide a new perspective from which to evaluate the events This book is a fascinating exploration of the art of leading troops in battle and will interest scholars and students of the Pacific War
