Geography of China

- Geography and climate divide China into two parts: north and south
- Core of China is a square region (1000 x 1000 miles) within distinct natural borders.
- Developed in even greater isolation than other ancient civilization like Egypt, Mesopotamia, and India
 - o Tendency toward isolationism in Chinese history develops, so that Chinese tended to see themselves as the center of the world.

Origins of Chinese History

- Agricultural revolution (domestication of rice): ca. 8000 BCE
- Hard to separate fact from legend.
- Archaeological evidence
 - o By 2000 BCE, the Longshan culture (along the Yellow River) was constructing walled settlements, casting bronze, making pottery, and using early version of Chinese script.
 - o Chinese legend attributes many of these innovations to five ancient sage emperors.

Shang Period (1750 – 1040 BCE)

Zhou Dynasty and Warring States

- Concept of "Mandate of Heaven" develops.
 - o Heaven (Dian) is an impartial arbiter.
 - Gives virtuous rulers the right to rule.
 - Justifies the removal of unjust rulers by others who are more morally suited to ruling.
- Zhou Dynasty fragments into small states ca. 500 – 221 BCE
- "Era of One Hundred Schools of Thought":
 - o Each with different answers to the questions of the nature of the worlds, ...

Confucius and his Teaching

- Kong fu zi ("Great master Kong"): 551 – 465 BCE
- Primary philosophy of China (and the rest of East Asia) for almost 2500 years. Emphasis on ethical leadership, personal moral behavior, and acceptance of proper place in society.
- Believed in restoring moral purity and virtue in society (especially in leaders) that supposedly existed in the "Golden Age" of the Zhou dynasty.
- Revolutionary redefinition of "gentleman" not based on birth but learning and character.
- Confucian virtues:
 - o Ren: Humaneness, respect, loyalty, empathy
 - o Qi: Intelligence, wisdom
 - o Yung: Courage
 - o Li: Dutifulness
 - o Xiao: Filial piety
