Unlocking the Brain: Volume 2: Consciousness Georg Northoff, 2013-11-11 Neuroscience has made considerable progress in figuring out how the brain works. We know much about the molecular genetic and biochemical underpinnings of sensory and motor functions. Recent neuroimaging work has opened the door to investigating the neural underpinnings of higher order cognitive functions such as memory, attention and even free will.
