Hallett examines the relationships between somatic and religious enclosure and the role of the senses in devotional discipline and practice, considering the ways in which the women adapted to the austerities of convent life after childhoods in domestic households. She considers the enduring effects of habitus in Bourdieu's terms, the residue of socialised subjectivity which was or was not transferred to a contemplative career. To this discussion she injects literary and cultural comparisons, considering *inter alia* how writers of fiction and of domestic and devotional conduct books represent the senses and how the nuns' own reading shaped their personal knowledge. *The Senses in Religious Communities 1600-1800* opens fresh comparative perspectives on the Catholic domestic household as well as the convent and on relationships between English and European philosophy, rhetorical, medical and devotional discourse.
