


Prevalence of food insecurity, average 2021-23

a right based approach to alleviating food insecurity hunger and malnutrition and in promoting access to and consumption of nutritionally adequate safe and culturally acceptable food on a sustainable basis for all It is now evident that with the current pace of events the goal set by the WFS and the MDG of halving poverty and hunger by 2015 will not be achieved There is a growing need to watch some of the possible effects of rapid economic globalisation and market liberalisation on food and nutrition security conditions and to promote countervailing measures to offset their most negative consequences particularly for vulnerable groups The right to food is a first test case of the extent to which the application of economic social and cultural rights can effectively exert such counterforce in an increasingly economics and market driven international climate and enhance progress towards established goals

clear gender inequalities in areas where both men and women's roles are visible for example in health education agriculture and in some remunerated work. The aim of this paper is to assess the social and economic costs of gender discrimination these costs are incurred in suboptimal resource allocation in lost agricultural productivity and in deficient nutrition of household members. This study argues that with the same access and control of productive resources by both male and female headed households in a given geographical area the levels of agricultural productivity and nutrition outcomes in male headed households should not be significantly different from those of female headed households. Any difference would be attributed to differences in access to resource caused by gender discrimination. The study analyses the food and nutrition situation in female and male headed households in relation to access to human capital financial capital and land. The results show that human and financial capitals are the main resources that caused variations in both agricultural productivity and nutritional status in the two categories of households. Despite male headed households having access to more land than the female headed households there was no significant difference in average area of land cultivated in the two categories of households. Economic cost analysis of unequal access to resources by gender is done using an econometric model.
