All perception may be selection, but if selection is guided by reason and the skills practiced by a good historian, both sides of many issues are not equally convincing. Historians cannot normally "prove" their arguments and historians cannot achieve absolute certainty, but in many areas, particularly outside the limited confines of strictly narrative history, we can do quite well with the surviving evidence. The inevitability of historical revisionism does not destroy the value of carefully done history. We are not absolutely free to choose any interpretation, no matter how insubstantial. The causes of the English civil war may remain controversial, and explanations of the Industrial Revolution may be far from complete harmony, but the rules of evidence and careful analysis can lead to significant agreement. Moreover, issues like the '45, happily enough, can be handled much more effectively, and perhaps even definitively.

Michael G. Ketcham. *Transparent Designs: Reading, Performance, and Form in the SPECTATOR Papers*. Athens, Ga.: The University of Georgia Press. 1985. Pp. vii, 216. \$25.00.

This excellent study brings into sharp and revealing focus the unique combination of formal flexibility, suave rhetorical technique and stylistic subtlety that Addison, Steele and other contributors achieved in *The Spectator*, the finest and most influential essay-journal of the eighteenth century. Professor Ketcham does not approach aspects of *The Spectator* in distortive and artificial isolation, as so many critics have. Though each chapter deals with a specific aspect of the journal, Professor Ketcham continually and very enlighteningly insists upon and demonstrates the interdependence of style, use of language, rhetoric, form, ideas, values, intended effects on the reader and actual reader responses. As a result, his book is important, stimulating and original about apparently familiar things. It repeatedly forced me to reconsider aspects of *The Spectator* on which I thought I had long since come to final and adequate conclusions.

Those with a special interest in Addison, Steele and the periodical essay will find much that is new and valuable here. For those with less specialized interests, this book also (and Professor Ketcham's frequent and well-considered allusions to Fielding reveal this was intended) provides insights into the broader field of eighteenth-century prose writing, especially the early novel. Though the book is consistently good, certain parts of it deserve special praise. The discussion of "Mr. Spectator" as *persona* in Chapter One is fascinating. The analysis of this at once "invisible" and dominant character, a judge as well as an observer and generator of values and manners, brings the subtlety of Addison's approach to the surface and suggests crucial affinities with the narratorial strategies of Fielding, Austen and other novelists. Among other things, it suggests that they learned how to narrate (how to relate to characters, actions and their readers), as well as how to write elegantly by reading *The Spectator*. The discussion of "gesture" and its moral-social "reading" by "Mr. Spectator" in Chapter Two is also very fine. Best of all, in some ways, is the discussion of prose style and language in Chapter Five, in which
