The product of graft slavery was America's first continuing criminal enterprise. However with Lord Chief Justice Mansfield's utterance in 1772 Let justice be done although the heavens fall a freedom trial of a slave named James Somerset and then Britain highest court's declaration that slavery was unconstitutional America's thirteen colonies exploded into rebellion. Myths developed to shield the founding generation and were used to further nationalist chauvinism. In 1779 Britain repudiated colonial lawlessness and in committing itself to the restoration of the rule of law tradition unconditionally freed all black slaves. And most strictly forbid any Person to sell or claim Right over any NEGROE sic. Four years later the U S sued for peace and by treaty agreed to set at liberty all British subjects but reneged and relegated 500 000 black British subjects into slavery. The U S exploited legally free British subjects in derogation of international law. The slavery narrative has overthrown
