Justice was vulnerable to power but was also mobilised to constrain it. Despite the key functions that the propertied fulfilled, courtroom crowds, the counter theatre of the condemned and the decisions of the victims from a very wide range of backgrounds had a role to play and the criteria on which decisions were based were shaped as much by the broad and more humane discourse which Fielding called the good mind as by the instrumental needs of the propertied elites.
