away a free man However the greedy valet the most highly paid spy in history at that time did not achieve his goals either he discovered some years later that the British banknotes he insisted on as payment were counterfeited by the Germans as part of a larger counterfeiting project Cicero died a desperate man deeply in debt a fitting anticlimax for an espionage episode resulting in neither bodily injury nor strategic impact but in humiliation on all sides The Einstein File Fred
