

THE GREAT KIVA

Great Kivas are special buildings that were used for community activities, including important ceremonies. Three-ring stones and pottery indicate that this Great Kiva was a relatively early building at Lomaki. It was constructed many times and used continuously for over 1,000 years.

When the Great Kiva was excavated, it showed that it was one of a more primitive type than the one at Lomaki shown above or the one at Pueblo Bonito (Chaco Canyon). The floor of this kiva is flat and rocky. It has no entrance, P-shaped masonry, or types of pottery from earlier in time. This evidence seems to indicate that this Great Kiva was the "laboratory" which tested pottery and masonry again and again at this site.

Several years ago while working on the Great Kiva in the flood (and erosion) layers, a Native from Santa Clara Pueblo interpreted the unique stone structures in the floor as symbols of Native people and Native people. "These stones because are like plantains that gives to everyone a need. Archaeologists are always trying to understand a certain past and a single stone has within each of these plantains."
