ecosystem as complex as the Great Barrier Reef is also vulnerable to a host of threats whether it's fishing, oil spills or climate change. J. E. N. Veron, former chief scientist of the Australian Institute of Marine Science, described watching how coral was affected during what's known as a mass bleaching event. And then I saw a whammy, a mass bleaching event where everything turns white and dies. Sometimes it's only the fast-growing branching corals, but some of the others are horrible to see: corals that are four, five, six hundred years old, they die too. It's real day in, day out, and I work on this day in, day out. It's like seeing a house on fire in slow motion. There's a fire to end all fires, and you're watching it in slow motion, and you have been for years. In fact, scientists fear that the Great Barrier Reef has lost most of its coral cover in the last 30 years, which poses a danger to the species that inhabit it, some of which are already endangered.
