Sonnets to Orpheus Rainer Maria Rilke, 2012-01-01 *Sonnets to Orpheus* is Rainer Maria Rilke's first and only sonnet sequence. It is an undisputed masterpiece by one of the greatest modern poets translated here by a master of translation. David Young Rilke revived and transformed the traditional sonnet sequence in the *Sonnets*. He captures Rilke's simple, concrete, and colloquial language, writing with a precision close to the original.
