Finally there is the theme of war and its social impact this volume considers not only the momentous effects of the Civil War but those of the Second World War particularly on the homefront. Drawn from the pages of the Tennessee Historical Quarterly these essays offer a well balanced look at the state's vibrant past. The book will prove an invaluable resource for teachers students researchers and general readers.
