Terminating psychoanalysis is not in the nature of a final chapter in a book. The analytic experience is intimately interwoven with the total texture of a person's life. Analysis reaches into the past and by its very nature goes on far beyond its terminal phase. At the same time, it is understood that technically and practically speaking analytic treatment has to be ended. There is a somewhat recondite connection between this principle and the ancient ritual of "The King is dead! Long live the King."

Conceptual Frame of Reference

In this paper my primary concern is to focus attention on concepts and technical considerations as they pertain to the terminal aspects of all analytic therapy. The goals and therapeutic approaches in short-term psychotherapy are of a somewhat different nature.

The conceptual framework of my presentation has in many respects evolved from the matrix of Sullivanian notions and formulations. Actually, Sullivan himself did not write anything on this particular subject; nor did he give a lecture or a talk dealing with termination, as far as I know. So let me make it clear that I am not expressing his specific views on the subject. I cannot tell you how he handled the final curtain. Instead I wish to sketch some notions of the process of therapy that have been partially formulated by Sullivan. His therapeutic method of observing human personality lends itself well as a background for highlighting certain landmarks in therapy.

Therapeutic Considerations

To Sullivan (1), therapy consists largely of participant observation in regard to personal vulnerabilities connected with anxiety and low self-esteem. Focal attention is directed toward inadequate and inappropriate performances in past and present living. The therapeutic interest is always in the personality as it relates to the demands of the personal situation. Both are so closely inter-
