Enthusiastic crowds in Paris and Alsace celebrated the return of the lost provinces but return proved far more difficult than expected. Over the following two decades politicians, administrators, industrialists, cultural elites and others grappled with the question of how to make the region French again. It connects the microhistory of the region with the macro levels of national policy, international relations and transnational networks and with the cross border flows of ideas, goods, people and cultural products that shaped daily life in Alsace as its population grappled with the meaning of return to France.
