codes were generated inductively and deductively. The results indicate that receiving support from various stakeholders is essential for teacher educators and that the motivation of the teacher educators is indispensable for initiating a learning garden in the teacher education programme. The teacher educators that started learning gardens mostly have previous experiences related to garden based learning. The teacher students and teacher educators perceived the learning garden as a place for experiential learning where the traditional student teacher relationship can be challenged. According to teacher students learning outcomes such as social competency, conscientiousness, self efficacy and action competency could be developed in the learning garden. It was found that teacher educators did not consider food system education in learning gardens to a great extent.
