know success while Emily's *Wuthering Heights* Anne's *The Tenant of Wildfell Hall* and other works were later to be accepted as masterpieces of literature. The three sisters and their brother Branwell 1817-1848 were very close and during childhood developed their imaginations first through oral storytelling and play set in an intricate imaginary world and then through the collaborative writing of increasingly complex stories set therein. The deaths of first their mother and then of their two older sisters marked them profoundly and influenced their writing as did the relative isolation in which they were raised.
