



HOW TO READ A SAFETY DATA SHEET

OSHA Brief

The most recent version of Standard Practice (OSHA-SP-010-2010) (revised 2010), revised 2010, replaces the chemical hazard communication standard, Hazard Communication Standard (HCS), which is the standard for the classification and labeling of chemicals. The HCS is a hazard communication standard that is intended to protect workers and consumers from exposure to health and physical hazards associated with chemicals by providing information on the hazards and protective measures. The HCS also includes information on the classification of mixtures.

The HCS identifies information such as the properties of each chemical (i.e., physical, health, and environmental health hazards, protective measures, and safety precautions for handling, storage, and disposal) that are important for health and safety. The information in the HCS must be available to employees through a label and a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS). The HCS provides specific information on hazard classification, hazard communication, and protective measures. The HCS also provides information on how to evaluate mixtures for hazard classification and how to communicate hazard information for mixtures.

Health Communication Standard (HCS) Sections 1 through 11 contain general information about the chemical, identification, hazard classification, label handling practices, and emergency contact information. This information should be helpful for those that must evaluate mixtures for hazard classification. Health Communication Standard Sections 1 through 11 also contain hazard communication information, including physical, health, and environmental information, as well as physical and chemical properties, hazard communication, toxicological information, exposure control information, and other information including the class of information on test results. The HCS must also contain information that is specific to the product itself and not just hazard information for any required hazard class.

The HCS must also contain Sections 1 through 11 in the sequence with the title (Section 1), hazard classification (Section 2), and labeling of chemicals (Section 3), test results (Section 4) and not contain the content of those sections because they interfere with the required hazard classification.

Section 1: Identification

THIS SECTION IDENTIFIES THE CHEMICAL, OR THE SDS AS WELL AS THE RECOMMENDED USE, IF ANY, PROVIDED BY THE ESSENTIAL CONTACT INFORMATION OF THE SUPPLIER.

- Product identifier (such as the label and any other common names or synonyms) by vehicle.
- Other names, numbers, phone numbers of the manufacturer, importer, or other responsible party, and emergency phone number.
- Exact name and use of the chemical (e.g., a brief description of what it actually does, health effects reference, and any restrictions on use (including relevant restrictions given by other agencies).



Section 2: Hazard(s) Identification

THIS SECTION IDENTIFIES THE HAZARDS OF THE CHEMICAL, PRESENTED ONE AT A TIME, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HAZARD CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM FOR CHEMICALS.

- The hazard classification of the chemical (e.g., Corrosive liquid, category 1).
- Segment identifier.
- Photographs (the photographs or hazard symbols may be presented as graphical representations of the symbols in black and white or a description of the name of the hazard symbol).
- Photographs (the photographs or hazard symbols may be presented as graphical representations of the symbols in black and white or a description of the name of the hazard symbol).
- Description of any hazards not otherwise classified.
- Information on how many ingredients are ingredient(s) with health hazards, a statement describing the health hazard(s) of the product, and the percentage of the ingredients that have health hazard(s). Present how many (in a total percentage of the mixture and not just for the individual ingredients).



Section 3: Ingredient Information

THIS SECTION IDENTIFIES THE INGREDIENTS, IDENTIFIED IN THE PRODUCT IDENTIFICATION SECTION, INCLUDING INFORMATION AND ESTABLISHED ADDITIVES, AND INCLUSES INFORMATION FOR SUBSTITUTES, INHIBITORS, AND ALL OTHER CHEMICALS MENTIONED IN TRADE SECRET OR COLONIAL.

- Chemical names.
- Chemical and common names.
- Chemical Abstracts Service (CAS) number and other unique identifiers.
- Chemical structure and other descriptive information, which are the most specific method and which contributes to the classification of the chemical.
- Chemicals where or how they are stored.
- A statement that the specific chemical identity and/or composition is not known.
- Information on how to obtain the specific chemical identity and/or composition if known.
- The CAS number for the ingredient of substantially similar mixture.

- Chemicals where or how they are stored.
- A statement that the specific chemical identity and/or composition is not known.
- Information on how to obtain the specific chemical identity and/or composition if known.
- The CAS number for the ingredient of substantially similar mixture.



Section 4: First-Aid Measures

THIS SECTION DESCRIBES THE FIRST-AID CARE THAT SHOULD BE PROVIDED BY RESPONDERS TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN EXPOSED TO THIS CHEMICAL.

- Necessary first-aid instructions (by relevant route of exposure (inhalation, skin and eye contact, and ingestion)).
- Description of the most important symptoms (or effects), and any symptoms that are serious, or delayed.
- Instructions for immediate medical care and special treatment needed, when necessary.

Section 5: Fire-Fighting Measures

THIS SECTION PROVIDES INFORMATION FOR FIGHTING A FIRE CAUSED BY THIS CHEMICAL.

- General information of the hazard(s) for fire-fighters, and information about extinguishing.
- Advice on what to do if an explosion (or other hazard) occurs.
- Advice on what hazards that develop from the chemical during fire-fighters, such as any explosive, flammable, products created when the chemical burns.
- Advice on extinguishing methods, equipment or protection for fire-fighters.

Section 6: Accidental Release Measures

THIS SECTION PROVIDES INFORMATION ON THE APPROPRIATE RESPONSE TO SPILLS, LEAKS, OR DISCHARGES OF THIS CHEMICAL, PROVIDED BY THE SUPPLIER, FOR THE HAZARD(S) IDENTIFIED IN SECTION 2. THIS SECTION ALSO PROVIDES INFORMATION ON SPILL PREVENTION, PREVENTION OF CONTAMINATION, AND SPILL MITIGATION MEASURES FOR LARGER SPILLS (SPILLS THAT ARE NOT SPILLS THAT ARE PREVENTED).

- Use of personal protection (such as removal of respirator or protective clothing, protective clothing, and protective equipment) to prevent the contamination of skin, eyes, and clothing.
- Emergency procedures, including instructions for evacuation, emergency shelter, and other emergency procedures.
- Methods for cleaning up.
- Advice on how to handle with care.
- Chemical countermeasures (e.g., countermeasures techniques for neutralization, decontamination, cleaning, or recovering) of environmental, domestic, and/or equipment required for containment/clean up.

Section 7: Handling and Storage

THIS SECTION PROVIDES INFORMATION ON THE SAFE HANDLING PRACTICES AND CONDITIONS FOR THIS CHEMICAL.

- Precautions for safe handling, including recommendations for handling, incompatible materials, protection of the user, and protection of the environment, and general measures (e.g., cleaning, training, and consulting).
- Recommendations on the conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities.

Section 8: Exposure Controls/Personal Protection

THIS SECTION INDICATES THE EXPOSURE LIMITS, ENGINEERING CONTROLS, AND PERSONAL PROTECTIVE MEASURES THAT ARE USED TO MINIMIZE WORKER EXPOSURE.

- Occupational Exposure Limits (OELs), American Conference of Governmental Industrial Hygienists (ACGIH), Threshold Limit Values (TLVs), and any other exposure limit used, as recommended by the chemical manufacturer, importer, or distributor preparing the safety data sheet, where available.
- Engineering controls.
- Personal protective equipment (e.g., respirator, protective clothing, or protective equipment for eyes and face).
- Recommendations for personal protective measures to prevent illness or injury from exposure to this chemical, such as personal protective equipment (e.g., respirators, types of protective clothing, and protective gloves).
- Any special measures for PPE, protection clothing, or respirators that are types of glove materials, such as PVC, or vinyl (chloro) gloves, and how to handle one of the glove materials.



Section 9: Physical and Chemical Properties

THIS SECTION IDENTIFIES PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS SUBSTANCE OR MIXTURE.

- Appearance (physical state, color, etc.).
- Odor.
- Odor threshold.
- pH.
- Melting point and boiling point.
- Flash point and auto-ignition point.
- Flammability (solid).
- Auto-ignition temperature.
- Decomposition temperature, and
- Viscosity.

This SDS may not contain every item on the above list. If no specific information exists for the relevant item or material, an indication of other effects should be made for that chemical (e.g., mutagenicity, teratogenicity, or any other health hazard). In addition, health or other hazard information (e.g., for nonflammable liquids), found in section 10, should be included in this section (generalized).



Section 10: Stability and Reactivity

THIS SECTION DESCRIBES THE REACTIVITY/STABILITY OF THIS CHEMICAL AND THE CHEMICAL INCOMPATIBILITY INFORMATION.

- Stability.
- Description of the specific test data for the chemical(s). This data can be a table or a summary of the chemical if the table does not adequately represent the anticipated hazard of the chemical, where possible.
- Chemical stability.
- Indication of whether the chemical is stable or unstable without normal conditions.
- Indication of any chemical reaction that may occur in storage and handling.
- Indication of any safety hazard that may occur in storage and handling.
- Other.
- Indication of the possibility of hazardous reactions, including an estimation whether the chemical will react with other substances, which may reduce its hazard or hazard, or cause other "hazardous" reaction.
- List of all conditions that should be avoided (e.g., heat, change, shock, vibration, etc.).
- List of all conditions that may be required to stabilize the product.
- List of any hazard or potential hazard due to decomposition products that could be produced because of heat, storage, or handling.

Section 11: Toxicological Information

THIS SECTION DESCRIBES TOXICOLOGICAL AND HEALTH EFFECTS INFORMATION ON SUBSTANCES WHICH OCCURS IN THIS CHEMICAL.

- Information on the likely effects on (skin, eyes, respiratory, nose and throat).
- The data should indicate if the information is estimated.
- Any specific information on chronic effects, or chronic effects that occur by repeated exposure to the chemical which is not adequately represented by the table.
- Description of estimated amount of a substance (e.g., expressed in parts per million) required to kill animals in a single dose.
- Description of the symptoms. This description includes the symptoms associated with exposure.
- Information on whether the chemical is a carcinogen based on the National Toxicology Program (NTP) report or other evidence-based information found to be a potential carcinogen in the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) monographs. Data obtained or based on information contained in the IARC monographs.

Section 12: Ecological Information

THIS SECTION PROVIDES INFORMATION TO DETERMINE THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT OF THIS CHEMICAL AT IT IS RELEASED TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

- Data on toxicity to aquatic life (e.g., fish, algae, invertebrates, and other aquatic organisms), where available.
- Data on effects on the environment, such as the effects on the environment, including the effects on the environment of the chemical(s) on the environment.
- Information on the potential for the chemical(s) to bioaccumulate and/or persist in the environment.
- Results of tests of bioconcentration potential, making reference to the potential hazard.
- Information on whether the chemical is a mutagen based on the National Toxicology Program (NTP) report or other evidence-based information found to be a potential mutagen in the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) monographs.
- Other adverse effects (e.g., environmental fate, ecotox, bioconcentration potential, persistence, bioaccumulation potential, and/or global warming potential).



Section 13: Disposal Considerations

THIS SECTION INDICATES APPROPRIATE DISPOSAL PRACTICES, INCLUDING THE DISPOSITION OF THIS CHEMICAL AS IT IS DISPOSED OF BY THE USER.

- Description of appropriate disposal practices.
- Information on disposal of empty, aquatic toxicity data for fish, algae, invertebrates, and other aquatic organisms.
- Information on disposal of the chemical(s) in the environment.
- Long-term effects of disposal on the environment.
- Any special precautions for disposal or treatment.
- Other adverse effects (e.g., environmental fate, ecotox, bioconcentration potential, persistence, bioaccumulation potential, and/or global warming potential).



Section 14: Transport Information

THIS SECTION PROVIDES INFORMATION ON CLASSIFICATION, LABELING, AND SHIPPING INFORMATION FOR THIS CHEMICAL.

- UN number.
- UN hazard class.
- UN hazard class (e.g., hazard class 1, hazard class 2, hazard class 3).
- Packing group number (if applicable, based on the degree of hazard).
- Environmental hazards (e.g., hazard class 1 for marine pollution hazard).
- Transport dangerous goods code (e.g., IATA, IBC, IMDG).
- Transport dangerous goods code (e.g., IATA, IBC, IMDG).
- Code for the Consignment and Transport of Dangerous Chemicals in Bulk (International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code).
- Information on special requirements for shipping, including the source of information (e.g., UN, IATA, IBC, IMDG).
- Information on emergency response, either within or outside the transport document, other information's not available.

Section 15: Regulatory Information

THIS SECTION DESCRIBES THE SAFETY, HEALTH, AND ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS THAT APPLY TO THIS PRODUCT, AS WELL AS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CHEMICAL UNDER THE REGULATIONS.

- Any relevant regulation, regulation, or standard, including the chemical, minimum, or maximum quantity, and any other relevant information.
- Information on the regulation of the chemical, minimum, or maximum quantity, and any other relevant information.

Section 16: Other Information

THIS SECTION PROVIDES ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE USE, PREPARATION, USE, AND DISPOSAL OF THIS CHEMICAL. THIS SECTION ALSO STATED WHAT OTHER CHEMICALS NEED TO BE USED TO PREPARE THIS CHEMICAL.

Employer Responsibilities

Employers must ensure that the information on this SDS is made available to all employees who work with this chemical. This may be done by making the SDS available at the worksite, or by making the SDS available on the employer's intranet or website. Employers must also ensure that the information on this SDS is made available to employees who may be exposed to this chemical in an emergency or other situation. For example, employers may need to make the SDS available in the event of a spill or other emergency. Furthermore, employers may need to identify a person responsible for obtaining and maintaining the SDS for their employees.
