Shafer,2003 Where did the Era of Divided Government come from What sustains split partisan control of the institutions of American national government year after year Why can it shift so easily from Democratic or Republican presidencies coupled with Republican or Democratic Congresses How can the vast array of issues and personalities that have surfaced in American politics over the last forty years fit so neatly within indeed reinforce the sustaining political pattern of our time These big questions constitute the puzzle of modern American politics The old answer a majority and a minority party plus dominant and recessive public issues will not work in the Era of Divided Government Byron Shafer a political scientist who is regarded as one of the most comprehensive and original thinkers on American politics provides a convincing new answer that has three major elements These elements in combination not divided government as a catch phrase are the real story of politics in our time The first element is comprised of two great sets of public preferences that manifest themselves at the ballot box as two majorities The old cluster of economic and welfare issues has not so much been displaced as simply joined by a second cluster of cultural and national concerns The second element can be seen in the behavior of political parties and party activists whose own preferences don t match those of the

general public. That public remains reliably left of the active Republican Party on economic and welfare issues and reliably right of the active Democratic Party on cultural and national concerns. The third crucial element is found in an institutional arrangement: the distinctively American matrix of governmental institutions which converts those first two elements into a framework for policymaking year in and year out. In the first half of the book Shafer examines how dominant features of the Reagan, first Bush, Clinton and second Bush administrations reflect the interplay of these three elements. Recent policy conflicts and institutional combatants in Shafer's analysis illuminate this new pattern of American politics. In the second half, he ranges across time and nations to put these modern elements and their composite pattern into a much larger historical and institutional framework. In this light, modern American politics appears not so much as new and different but as a distinctive recombination of familiar elements of a political style, a political process and a political conflict that has been running for a much much longer time.

Presidential Lightning Rods Richard J. Ellis, 1994

Choice Outstanding Title H R Haldeman President Nixon's former chief of staff is said to have boasted: Every president needs a son of a bitch and I'm Nixon's I'm his buffer and I'm his bastard I get done what he wants done and I take the heat instead of him. Richard Ellis explores the widely discussed but poorly understood phenomenon of presidential lightning rods: cabinet officials who take the heat instead of their bosses. Whether by intent or circumstance these officials divert criticism and blame away from their presidents. The phenomenon is so common that it's assumed to be an essential item in every president's managerial toolbox. But Ellis argues such assumptions can oversimplify our understanding of this tool. Ellis advises against indiscriminate use of the lightning rod metaphor. Such labeling can hide as much as it reveals about presidential administration and policymaking at the cabinet level. The metaphor often misleads by suggesting strategic intent on the president's part while obscuring the calculations and objectives of presidential adversaries and the lightning rods themselves. Ellis also illuminates the opportunities and difficulties that various presidential posts especially secretaries of state, chiefs of staff and vice presidents have offered for deflecting blame from our presidents. His study offers numerous detailed and instructive examples from the administrations of Truman, Dean Acheson, Eisenhower, Richard Nixon, John Foster Dulles, Herbert Brownell and Ezra Taft Benson, LBJ, Hubert Humphrey, Ford, Henry Kissinger and Reagan, James Watt. These examples Ellis suggests should guide our understanding of the relationship between lightning rods and presidential leadership, policymaking and ratings. Blame avoidance he warns does have its limitations and may even backfire at times. Nevertheless, President Clinton and his successors may need to rely on such tools. The presidency, Ellis points out, finds itself the object of increasingly intense partisan debate and microscopic scrutiny by a wary press. Lightning rods can deflect such heat and help the president test policies, gauge public opinion and protect his political power and public image. Ellis's book is an essential primer for helping

Urofsky,1997 Affirmative action continues to be one of the most hotly contested issues in America Volatile and divisive the debates over its legitimacy have inspired a number of reverse discrimination suits in the federal courts Like the landmark 1978 Bakke decision most of these have focused on preferential treatment given racial minorities In *Johnson v Santa Clara* however the central issue was gender not race discrimination and the Supreme Court's decision in that case marked a resounding victory for women in the work force *Johnson v Santa Clara* involved two people who in 1980 competed for a dispatcher position with the transportation department of Santa Clara County California Paul Johnson had more experience and slightly higher test scores but Diane Joyce was given the job based on affirmative action An irate Johnson sued the county and won only to have the decision reversed in appellate court That reversal was subsequently upheld in the Supreme Court's 1987 decision reaffirming that it was legitimate for employers to consider gender in hiring Preeminent legal historian Melvin Urofsky proves an exemplary guide through the complexities of this case as he takes us from the workplace through the various levels of our federal court system Balancing the particulars of the case with an overview of constitutional law and judicial process he creates a model legal history that is both appealing and enlightening for the non scholar Urofsky is especially good at highlighting the fundamental human drama of this case and shows how Johnson and Joyce were simply ordinary people each with valid reasons for their actions but both ultimately caught up in legal and social issues that reached well beyond their own lives Affirmative Action on Trial pointedly addresses the issue of sex discrimination and the broader controversy over the place of affirmative action in American society The latter continues to generate headlines like those that followed the 1996 Supreme Court decision to let stand a lower court ruling that race cannot be used as a determination for admission to academic programs More recently several states have even taken steps to end affirmative action altogether While it's hard to tell how such actions will ultimately impact affirmative action there's no question that the rulings in cases like *Johnson v Santa Clara* will continue to guide and influence the debates both inside and outside the courtroom
