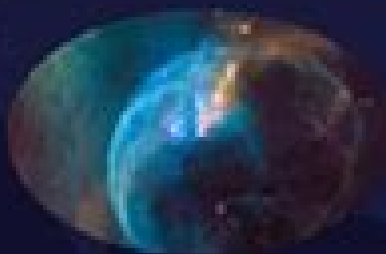


SOLAR SYSTEM'S EVOLUTION

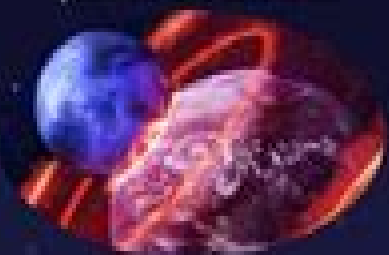
The Earth Today:
