

where he died in 1708. But one child is mentioned, Abraham (4).

PETER WATSON (3), landed on Staten Island, December 19, 1683, having been brought out under a four-year indenture. After a few years spent in Middlesex county, he removed to a plantation about one-half mile south of the present village of Freneau, now known as Magnolia Farm. This eventually grew to about 400 acres. He appears to have been very active in both church and worldly affairs and to have accumulated various properties in this and adjoining counties, including dock and store properties at Matawan. In his will he mentions his wife, Agnes. She was probably a second wife and not the mother of his children. He died in 1729, leaving sons: Peter (5), a merchant of Freehold, who died intestate in 1712; William (6); Richard (7); Gavin (8); and, David, (9). There may have been daughters.

CAPTAIN ABRAHAM WATSON (4), son of John (2), died in 1750. His tombstone is still to be seen in one of the graveyards in Middletown village. The name of his wife was Elizabeth. But one child is known, John (10).

WILLIAM WATSON (6), son of Peter (3), died in 1751. He left two daughters—Euphemia (11), died 5-8-1770, aged 41, who married Michael Johnstone, and, Margaret (12), who does not seem to have married.

RICHARD WATSON (7), son of Peter (3), died in 1734. The given-name of his wife was Martha. Their children were: Peter (13); James (14); Richard (15); Ann (16); Margaret (17); Euphemia (18); Mary (19); and, Jean (20), who married William Jolly.

GAVIN WATSON (8), son of Peter (3), probably lived in Manalapan. His children were: Gavin (21); Peter (22), of Freehold, who died 1761, having married Mary Ker; Euphemia (23), who married Joseph Ker; and, Ann (24), who married Walter Ker.

DAVID WATSON (9), son of Peter (3) lived on the homestead at Mt. Pleasant. His wife is thought to have been a daughter of Alexander Napier. His children are supposed to have been: David (25), who is thought to have married, 1750, Ann Tice, and who had no children; Margaret (26); Agnes (27), mother of Philip Freneau, the Poet, 1728-1817, who married, first, Pierre Freneau, and, secondly, Major James Kearney; Eliza-

beth (28), who married Zilpha Smith; and, Euphemia (29), who married Joseph Smith.

JOHN WATSON (10), son of Capt. Abraham (4), married Hope, daughter of John and Sarah (Hartshorne) Taylor. She was born 1721, and died, 10-27-1792. She married, as second husband, Captain John Burrowes, of Matawan, to whom she bore several children. John and Hope Taylor had children: Abraham (30), who left no issue; Elizabeth (31), who married John Stillwell, of Garret's Hill, son of Joseph; and, Sarah (32), born 1740, married Colonel Asher Holmes, who so ably commanded the Monmouth militia during the Revolution.

JONATHAN BURDGE (1), founder of the Monmouth county family of that name, was of Cow Bay, Long Island. He had at least one child, Jonathan (2).

JONATHAN BURDGE (2), son of Jonathan (1), married Mary Ellison, of Long Island. Their children were: (sup.) David (3); Hannah (4), who married as third wife, Thomas Morford, 1692-1750; Richard (5); Joseph (6), who married, 1765, Zilpha Clifford; Susan (7); Deborah (8), who married, 1741, James Pew; and, Jonathan (9).

DAVID BURDGE (3), supposed son of Jonathan (2), died 1760. His wife was Patience Woolley. Their children are given as: Benjamin (10); supposed Jacob (11); and, perhaps, Uriah (12).

RICHARD BURDGE (5), son of Jonathan (2), married, as first wife, Susan Wall, 1725-1754, daughter of Garret. The name of his second wife has not been recovered. By the first marriage there was one daughter, Hannah, 1744-1807, who married Joseph Dorsett, 1743-1831. By the second wife there was one son, Reverend Michael (14), who was still living in 1840.

BENJAMIN BURDGE (10), son of David (3), was born in 1747. He was father of at least one child, Eleanor, (14½), who married Jonathan McCane.

JACOB BURDGE (11), supposed son of David (3), was born June 6, 1743, O. S. The given name of his wife was Judith, who was born July 8, 1751. Their children were: Lydia (15), born Aug. 23, 1770; Joseph (16), born March 31, 1772; and, Anthony, born Oct. 12, 1774.
