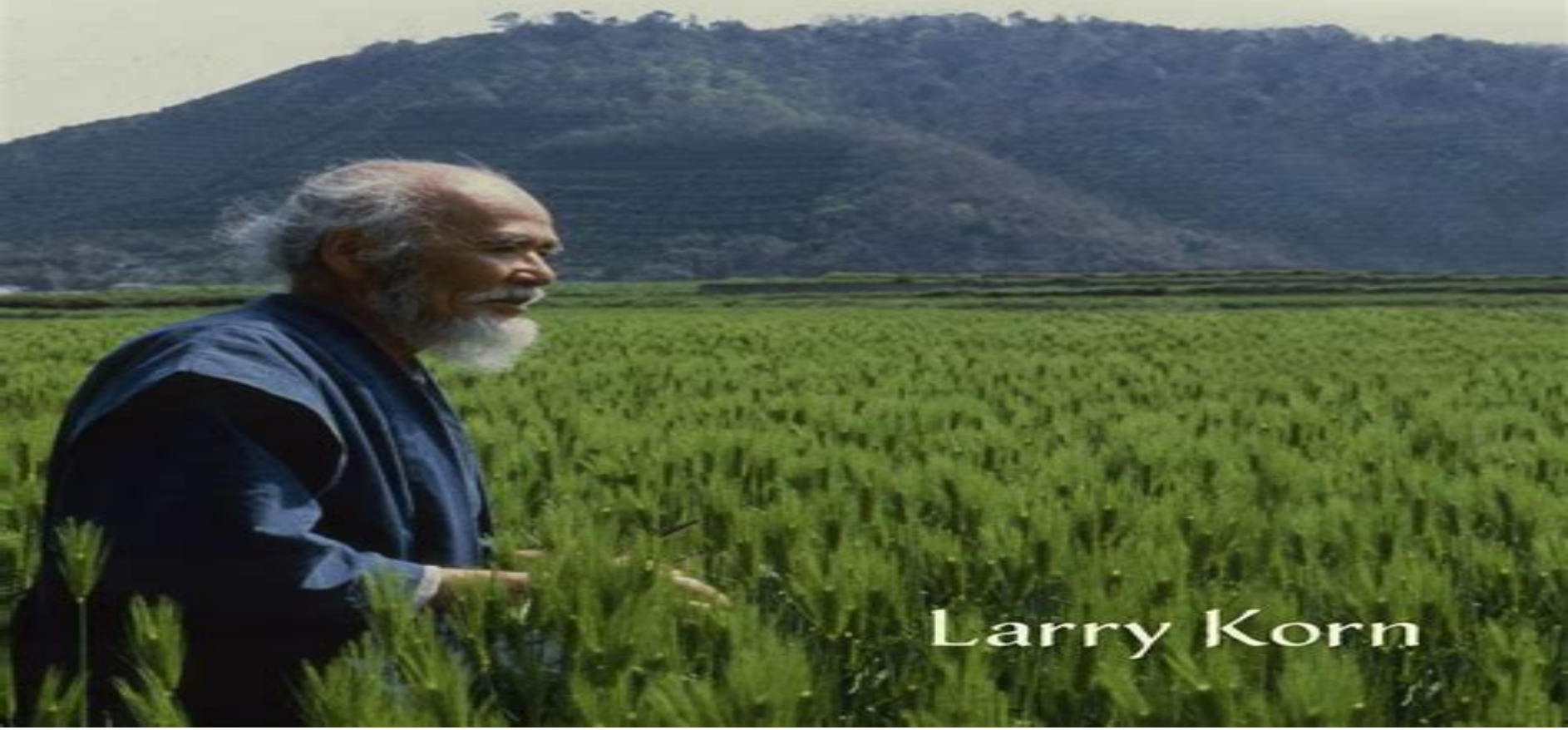

Korn also clarifies commonly held misconceptions about natural farming.
