


Origin of Eukaryotic Cells

- **Endosymbiont Theory:** Eukaryotic cells arose from living communities formed by prokaryotic organisms.
- The evolution towards eukaryotic cells began between 1.5 and 2 billion years ago in what is known as *"endosymbiosis": an internal, mutually beneficial relationship.*
- Small *aerobic prokaryotes* are thought to have entered and lived inside larger anaerobic prokaryotes. Later additional small *photosynthetic prokaryotes* are also thought to have entered and lived inside.
