- Born 1865 in Freiberg, Moravia to Jacob, his wool-merchant father. Mother was Jacob's third wife.
 - Moved to Vienna in 1860 until 1938.
- Vienna exciting place of opportunity and optimism. In 1867, Jews granted political rights and accepted into society.
 - Freud assimilated, identifying as a German.
- About the time he was 15, liberal political atmosphere evaporated and anti-Semitism became virulent, shattering assimilation
- Graduated from University of Vienna medical school with strong interest in research but quickly married and realized only private practice would
