

- Two different strategies
 1. Detailed Knowledge of the fundamental dynamics (e.g string theory) controlling the BH microscopic degrees of freedom is necessary
 2. Area law should have some explanation also at the level of the low-energy effective theory describing the BH
- Usually 1. uses non-perturbative solutions of string theory and some duality (e.g AdS/CFT) to map the BH into a weak-coupled system
 - Nice example: Strominger and Vafa calculation of the entropy of the 5D extremal RN black hole.
 - Bad features:
 - Rely on SUSY
 - Works only for BPS states (extremal BH and BB)
