cards will make our friends smile," Jinks said, smiling at her artwork.

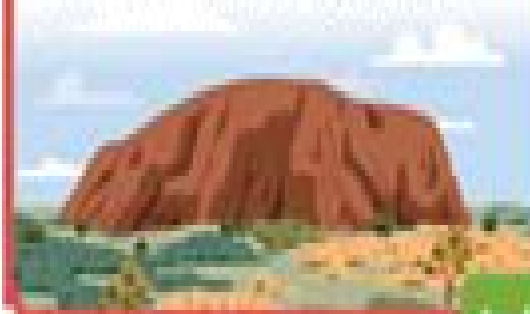
High up in the gum tree, Charlie the kookaburra was ready to ring the magical
