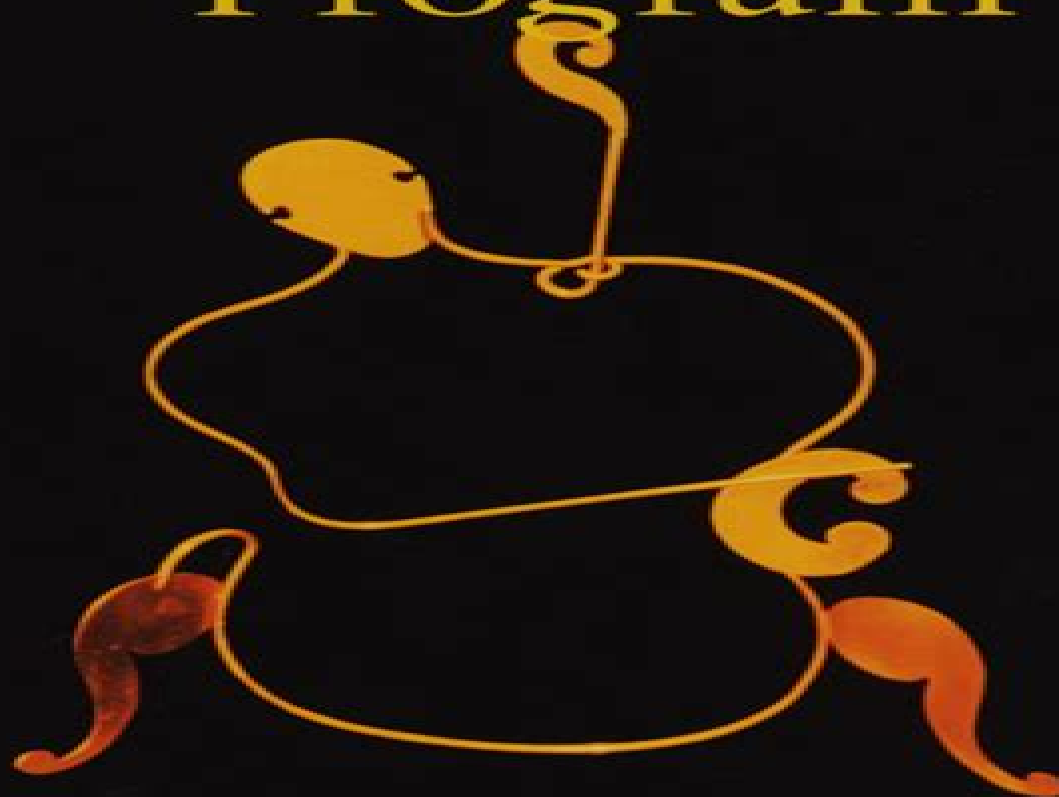

In many respects therefore these articles develop alternatives to ideas proposed in chapter 4 Categories and Transformations of Chomsky's most recent book The Minimalist Program 1995b. Some of the articles contain references to chapter 4 and some comments on similarities and differences between ideas developed in these papers and in chapter 4 of Chomsky 1995b can also be found in the Introduction to this volume.
