Frank Norris Revisited Joseph R. McElrath, 1992 The renown Frank Norris attained in his brief lifetime sprang from his compelling and to many Americans startling novels about people whose lives have escaped their control and have become grotesquely warped by the confluent forces of hereditary and environment In the decades after his death in 1902 though this broad appeal fossilized to some degree and Norris's Naturalistic novels entered the domain of the literary historian serving as benchmarks in the genre's evolution Fortunately for this author of
