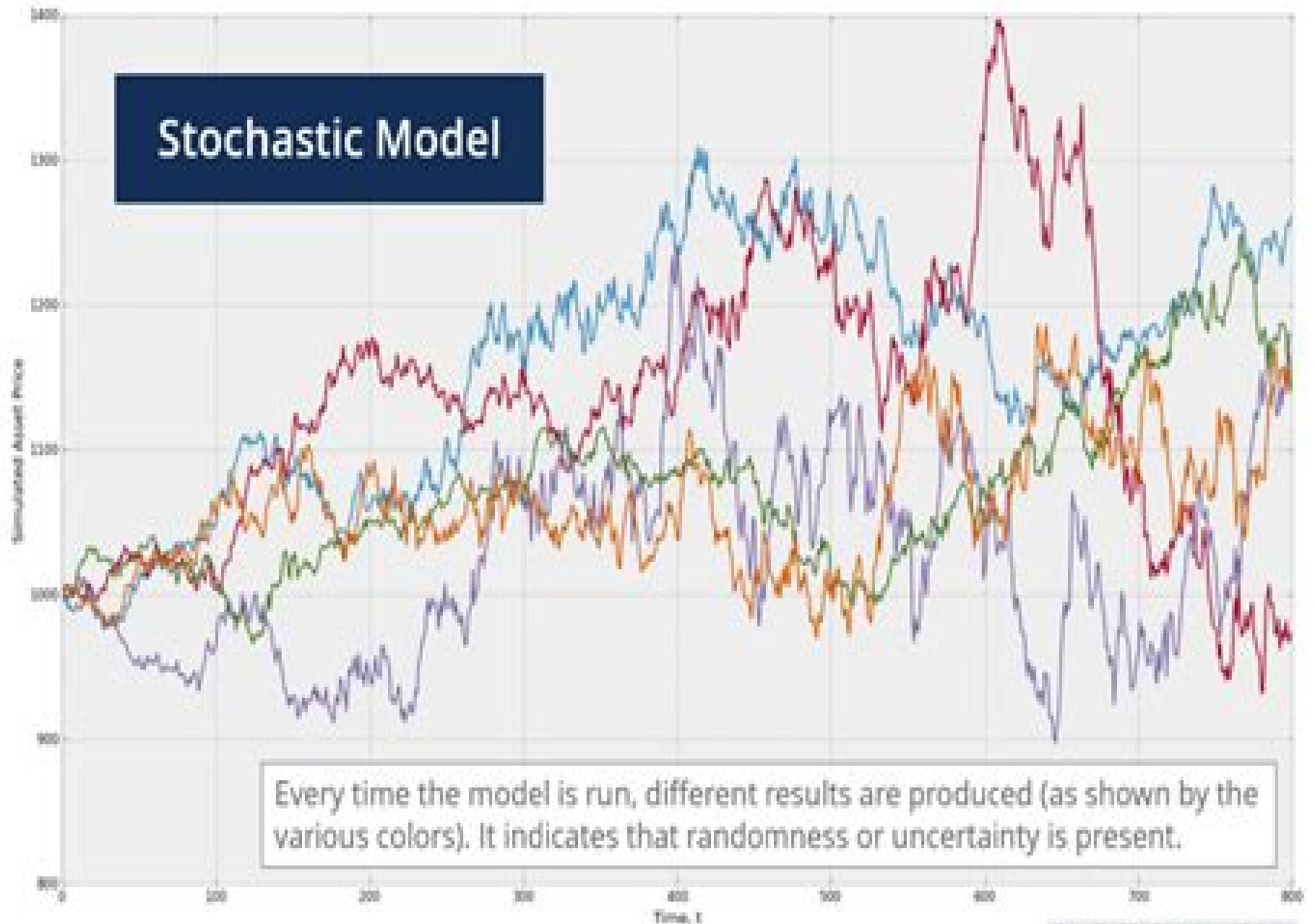


Stochastic Model
