Identifying patterns of exclusion from participation in sport and physical activity is also the focus of Chapter 13 which is authored by Wendy Frisby, Colleen Reid and Pamela Ponc. This chapter demonstrates how a combination of poverty and prevailing municipal recreation department policies seriously limit the opportunities of many women from active recreation. In Chapter 14 Brian Wilson explores how the media reinforces taken-for-granted understandings of gender appropriate orientations toward the body and sport. In the following chapter Jamie Bryshun and Kevin Young provide some of the first substantial evidence for the routine involvement of female athletes in initiation/hazing rituals in Canada and conclude that power relations between neophyte and veteran female players may be just as aggressive/coercive and high risk as those occurring on male teams.
