


The Seder table is traditionally set with a festive tablecloth and the family's finest china and silverware, and family members come to the table dressed in their holiday clothes. The rituals and symbolic foods evoke the themes of slavery and freedom that are commemorated and celebrated during the evening.

At the head of the table, within reach of the leader, is a Seder plate containing various symbolic foods that will be eaten or pointed out during the course of the Seder. This special plate has six designated areas for the foods that go on the Seder plate:

- Z'roah – A lamb shank, a remembrance of the Passover lamb and how the Israelites in Egypt were kept safe from the final plague when they placed the blood of the lamb on their doorposts.
- Maror – Horseradish, representing the bitterness and harshness of slavery.
- Charoset – A sweet paste of chopped apples and nuts, mixed with sweet wine, honey, and cinnamon, charoset represents the mortar used by the Jewish slaves to build the storehouses of Egypt.
- Karpas – Parsley reminds us of spring and rebirth.
- Chazeret – A second bitter herb, typically romaine lettuce.
