Historical Truth in Fifteenth-Century Italy Giuliano Mori,2024 While humanists agreed on identifying the main requirement of the historical genre with truthfulness they disagreed on their notions of historical truth Some authors equated historical truth with verisimilitude thus harmonizing the quest for truth with other ingredients of their histories such as their political utility and rhetorical aptness Others instead rejected the notion of verisimilitude identifying historical truth with factuality Accordingly they sought to produce bare and exhaustive accounts of all the things that pertained to their
