- This poem is a section from the Four Ancient Books of Wales, by William F. Skene(1868)
- The Gododdin were a Brythonic people of north-eastern Britain in sub-Roman period, best known as the subject of the 7th century Welsh series of poems known as *Y Gododdin*.
- The name Gododdin is the Modern Welsh form; it is derived from the Brythonic language word *Votadini*, confirmed in Latin texts.
