


Human Nature

An optimistic and plastic view of human nature

- Like liberalism, socialists have an **optimistic view** of human nature, but for different reasons. While **liberals** believe individuals are naturally **self-reliant** and **self-sufficient**, **socialists** believe humans are naturally **cooperative**, **generous** and **altruistic**. Thus, where **liberals** advocate **individualism**, **socialism** advocates **collectivism**, claiming we can only be understood in terms of the social groups we belong to.
- Socialists believe humans are **social creatures**, capable of overcoming social and economic problems by drawing on **community** and **cooperation** rather than competition or individual effort, like liberals. Their collectivist vision of society is based on **John Donne** notion that "*no man is an island... everyman is a piece of the continent, part of the main*". Subsequently, they advocate the **principle of fraternity**, which is the idea that we are all **comrades**, brother and sisters tied to each other by common bonds of humanity.
- The social view of human nature based on community and cooperation has led socialists to encourage **communal living**. E.g. **Charles Fourier** advocated independent communities, called 'phalansteries', based on **communal ownership** and **production**, in which there would be **equal distribution of resources** and a culture of **tolerance** and **permissiveness**. Likewise, **Robert Owen** developed the New Harmony model based on cooperative communities in Scotland and America. This involved **shared ownership**, **responsibility** and **altruism**.
